

12th Conference on Methods and Applications of Fluorescence

Strasbourg, France

11 -14 September 2011



The series of conferences on Methods and Applications of Fluorescence: Spectroscopy, Imaging and Probes (MAF) started in Graz (1989, 1991) and is held now every two years in European countries (Prague, 1993; Cambridge, 1995; Berlin, 1997; Paris, 1999; Amsterdam, 2001; Prague, 2003; Lisbon, 2005), Salzburg, 2007; Budapest, 2009).

MAF-12 will gather experts from all over the world to discuss the state of the art in fluorescence techniques and applications. The conference is aimed at researchers from universities, research institutes, and companies who apply fluorescence-based technologies in their products. It is highly multidisciplinary and will bring together scientists working in areas such as chemistry, physics, biology, pharmacology, medicine, and material (nano)sciences.

Twenty four speakers of highest level will be invited to present their latest results. Additionally, thirty communications will be selected from the submitted abstracts, and their authors will be asked to give a talk. We welcome contributions on new spectroscopic methods and techniques, fluorescent probes, and (nano)materials, and on methods of fluorescent imaging.

This MAF conference will become a high-ranking conference of interest owing not only to its cutting-edge scientific content, but also due to its attractive location and social program that render MAF conferences so very special. The number of participants will be limited to 450. We are looking forward to welcoming you to Strasbourg in September 2011.
